It has been an operational flour mill for 1004 years old. That's old !!



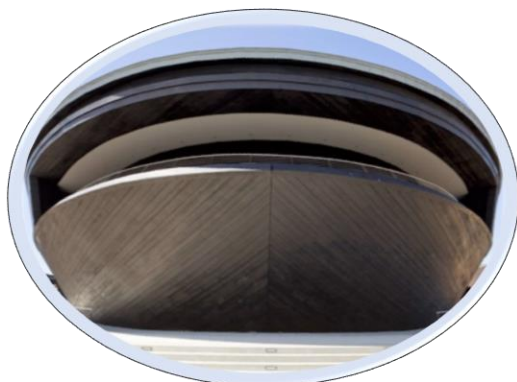
Where is this "small" wedding being held? – A trick question!!

Who was this famous local Squire & what is he known as? - Capt Lewis
Tregonwell recognised as the Founder of Bournemouth, his statue stands
outside the B.I.C. On land that was his original estate of 8.5 acres, bought for
£179 11s (then thought a fortune for land that was worthless). Now worth £34m



Where & what is this & what is its connection with the Gent above? -
Royal Exeter Hotel, Exeter Road, Bournemouth. The centre section
pictured was the first house built in the "Bourne Mouth" called The
"Mansion" by Capt Tregonwell & his wife, which is opposite the B.I.C.



Not a Macaroon, so what is it? – No, it's not edible !!
It's the seaward side of the new Mary Rose Museum rebuilt
around the ship at £5.4m & reopened in 2017. A must see !!
